

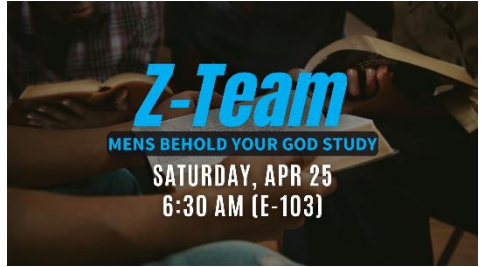
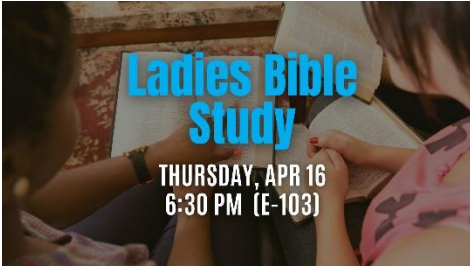


**WELCOMES YOU TO OUR MORNING WORSHIP**
