Approaching the Resurrection:

I. Start with the _____ you have (Mark 16:1-2).

The women were doing what they could, and that took courage.

The women didn’t understand it all fully. And that’s ok.

“You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart.”

- Jeremiah 29:13

II. There are things that will _____ you from _____ in Jesus (Mark 16:3-4).

“This might be a wasted effort” – the impact of worries that never come to fruition...

Do you have a list of “what if’s” and “what about’s?”

Must you have every question answered before you seek God?

Spoiler alert: God doesn’t promise heaven on earth. In fact, He promises trials.

“And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him” (Hebrews 11:6).

III. God _____ that you _____ what He says (Mark 16:5-7)

They were given revelation – a word to accept or reject. (*as have we*)

The ONLY reason to not be alarmed is Jesus has risen!

“...tell his disciples and Peter” (vs. 7). (and you and me!)

IV. Live a life of passionate _____ (Mark 16:8).

Trembling (Gk. tromos) – a fear under solemn responsibility.

Astonishment (Gk. ekstasis – a displacement of the mind from its ordinary state and self-possession.
